Discuss & Adopt New Operating Polices & Procedures Document- Discussion Chip Hill

Chairperson thanked all those who have been reviewing and commenting on the shared document for the Operations Policies and Procedures. Chip and Ross have been very diligent in

their comments, changes and enhancements needed to update the document. This will consolidate the info and place in one easy to find location for the membership. Ross made the Club presentation to the CCOC and we are awaiting approval of the Club ByLaws from the Board of Directors SCLH.

Chip Hill asked that the Operating Policy related to

- Mentoring needs to be closely reviewed as he is unfamiliar with the details necessary since it the activities has currently undergone some updating. Jerry Grisler and Mel Switzer will work together to review and update. It was agreed that this would be presented at the meeting next month.
- Steering Committee definitions need some work, perhaps leave descriptions general but provide a link to the actual section in the document for in depth descriptors. Do not use committee members names since it would require updating based on election terms.
- Chip Hill plans to rework the order of the Document since it doesn't flow with how membership flows on joining the club.
- Also needing update is the dues payment info. Due on January 10 to January 15 AND a grace period until January 31st.
- Also suggested is the Acronyms be spelled out at least once throughout the document.
- Definition of a "BLOCK" needs updating, should it include a "jump" further clarification
- Hitting the floats- all floats (noodles vs lane lines) needs to be uniform in its descriptor
- Ball over the net is an ATTACK- define specifically on a set/pass or if it drifts over the net
